#### **PENN REELS SOLD**

January 2003 - Philadelphia, PA

Penn Fishing Tackle Manufacturing Company of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania has been sold to Sea Striker Inc. of Morehead City, North Carolina and Master Fishing Tackle of Carson, California for an undisclosed amount. Jerry and Lavonne Rodstein, owners of Master Fishing Tackle, and Dick and Phyllis Henry and Al Brister, owners of Sea Striker, purchased all shares of Penn Fishing Tackle from the Henze family, who owned and operated Penn for the past 70 years.

Penn, already one of the world's largest marketers of high quality saltwater fishing reels and rods, grows even stronger with its strategic partnership with Sea Striker and Master Fishing Tackle. Sea Striker, best known for its Billfisher line of rods and terminal tackle, is also the parent company of Star rods, a high-end fishing rod manufacturer, and Master Fishing Tackle, best known for its Roddy line of imported rod and reel combos sold throughout the United States, provide Penn Fishing Tackle with resources and product development capabilities to lead Penn into the next century of tackle manufacturing and marketing.

Mr. Kevin Martin, who served as Chief Operating Officer for the past year under the Henze's ownership, was named President and Chief Executive Officer by the new owners. Mr. Martin brings with him a strong marketing and qualityoriented background, refined at his previous positions, the last being President and CEO of Spalding Sports Worldwide. Mr. Martin commented on the recent sale of the company stating, "The combination of Penn. Sea Striker and Master will expand our rod, reel and combo business, and immediately improve customer service and product availability."

Penn Fishing Tackle, founded in 1932 by Otto Henze, has established itself as the premier saltwater fishing tackle company. With 1200plus world records attributed to its reels and more than 200 world records to its rods, no other tackle company even comes close to the world-record setting success of Penn.

Penn Reels® - History

#### **PENN REELS: HISTORY**

The year 2004 will be the 72nd. consecutive year that Penn has been making fishing reels right here in the United States. The history of Penn is a fascinating American success story. It's the story of a young man who came to America and worked his way from a machine operator, to the owner of the greatest fishing tackle company the world has ever known.

Otto Henze was born in 1897 in a small town in northern Germany. In 1922, he boarded a ship and came to the United States in search of a brighter future. A machinist by trade, he settled in Philadelphia where he honed his skills as an employee of the Ocean City Reels Company. But Mr. Henze had greater aspirations. He wanted to run his own company, and believed that he could make a high-quality fishing reel that would be affordable for the average consumer.

In 1932, with the financial backing of Mr. George Hunt, Otto Henze rented space in a third floor loft at 492 North Third Street in Philadelphia, a facility owned and operated by William Schmitz & Co., General Machinists. Mr. Henze spent the year designing prototype reels and securing the necessary parts to make samples. His first prototype reel, named the "MOD F", was a simple, direct-drive reel comprised of 23 parts held together by 10 screws. A second prototype, the "MOD K", was also developed.

In September 1932, Mr. Henze named his new company the Penn Fishing Tackle Manufacturing Company, in honor of one of the country's founding fathers – William Penn. In February 1933, Otto Henze began selling his fishing reels to the general public. The Mod F was renamed Sea Hawk, and the Mod K became known as the Bayside. A third reel, the Long Beach, was also introduced, with a star drag. The company's first recorded sale occurred that month to the Miller Auto Supply Company of Harrisburg, Pennsylvania. Miller purchased one of each Penn reel - a Sea Hawk for \$1.21, a Bayside for \$1.93 and a Long Beach for \$2.48. Otto Henze was in business.

A fourth reel was introduced in October, 1933 - the Seaford. By the end of 1933, Penn Fishing Tackle Manufacturing Company moved into a larger facility at 159 W. Lehigh Avenue. First year sales were





\$7,526.38. It was not a good time for a company to be starting out. The Great Depression reached its low point in 1933, and many companies went bankrupt. By the end of 1933, one in four workers in the United States were unemployed.

But Mr. Henze persevered. He was convinced that with the economy depressed, more and more people would have to fish for their food. Instead of cutting back, he made more and more reels. The company doubled the number of reels it offered from 1933 to 1934. Mr. Henze's hunch was right – sales soared to over \$47,000 in 1934 and by 1935, sales surpassed \$66,000. Otto Henze was living the American dream – a European immigrant who worked his way up from the shop floor, started his own company, survived the depression, and was now running the fastest growing fishing reel company in America. But Otto Henze wasn't about to sit back and rest on his laurels. He went back to the drawing board and designed a reel that would make him a legend.

#### **BIG FISH BEWARE**

Most of Penn's earliest models were built for the beach or bay fisherman. As such, Penn quickly established itself as an expert in "saltwater" fishing. Otto Henze saw an opportunity to make a big game saltwater reel that would be within the means of the average fisherman. It was his contention that the "high cost of reels had prevented thousands from enjoying this major fishing sport." In 1936, Otto Henze introduced the Penn Senator, a revolutionary new reel capable of challenging the biggest, most powerful game fish in the sea. It was a simple design, light in weight, yet extremely strong. The Senator was sold for a price of \$25, and by the end of the year, fisherman were setting world records with Mr. Henze's latest invention. Even today, the Senator remains a favorite of fishermen the world over.

The year 1936 saw another milestone for Otto Henze. He met and fell in love with Martha, and they married. They started a family that grew to include two sons and a daughter. Martha devoted her time to raising the children and managing their home, but she also had a keen interest in the business and in her husband's fascination with saltwater fishing.

#### A GIFT TO SURF FISHERMEN

With the tremendous success of the Senator driving sales for Penn in the mid-30's, Otto Henze turned his attention to the surf caster and introduced another revolutionary fishing reel – the Penn "Squidder." Otto was an avid fisherman and he saw a need for a reel that could cast further with fewer backlashes and still handle bigger fish with ease. The Squidder boasted an improved drag system, a higher retrieve ratio, and a counterbalanced handle that made it the fastest, smoothest, most forgiving reel of its day, and for decades to come.

#### FIRST LADY OF SALTWATER REELS

By the end of the decade, Otto Henze had established Penn as the preeminent manufacturer of high-quality saltwater fishing reels. Letters with pictures of record fish came in from all over the world and Penn became the mainstay of charter boat captains and serious anglers for their performance, reliability and parts availability. New products were introduced in each successive year and older models were refined and improved.

In 1943, Penn moved into an even larger building on West Hunting Park Avenue, where it is still headquartered today. In addition to making fishing reels, a portion of the plant was dedicated to making ammunition for the troops in World War II. In 1948, Otto Henze died suddenly, leaving Martha with a thriving business in need of strong leadership. Martha did something few women of the time would even consider. At the age of 39, she took responsibility for running Penn Fishing Tackle Manufacturing Company as its President. Penn continued to prosper under Martha's surprising management skills, as she won the support and adoration of all Penn employees.

Martha wasn't just a successful business executive at a time when women were rarely seen in corporate management, she was an avid angler in her own right. She relished fishing distant waters and caught salmon in Alaska, tarpon in Costa Rica, and bluefin tuna in Nova Scotia, including one that tipped the scales at 613-pounds. This fish is on display today at Penn's corporate headquarters.







## CONSERVATION

Otto Henze had recognized the importance of saltwater fishing as a sport long before most fishermen, and he promoted an ethical approach to angling decades before the coining of the term "catch and release." In Penn's 1941 Catalog, the company presented an article entitled "Fish for the Sport" which contains the following prophetic words alongside a Penn employee "releasing" a tarpon:

Let's not forget that there should be just as high a code of ethics in saltwater fishing as in any other sport. Fish for the sport of CATCHING fish. Catch all you can, but why KILL all the fish that will not be used. Set your own limit and RELEASE fish to furnish sport in the future. Most game fish can be returned to the water unharmed. Let's not overlook the fact that the supply of game fish can be reduced to the point of extinction. Don't be a FISH HOG.

Otto's concern for the health of the ocean's fisheries and for the preservation of our great sport was instilled in the company's culture. Penn remains today a leader in the fight for conservation by supporting organizations attempting to reverse decades of commercial over-fishing, and those who protect the rights of recreational fishermen.

#### RESEARCH AND TESTING

One of the many keys to Penn's success was a passion for research and testing of products to ensure quality. Otto Henze was so obsessed with drag performance and dependable operation that he invented machines to push the limits of his reels. One was a rotary drum driven by a massive electric motor mounted to the floor in the factory with a fighting chair and footrest mounted opposite. He would spend hours in the chair testing drag configurations at line speeds and stress levels far in excess of anything the reels would come up against on the water.

Martha learned from Otto's testing methods and implemented a few of her own. The 1950's saw the Penn Sportfisher set sail, a boat owned by Penn for the specific purpose of testing all new reels on the water.

Rigid test procedures were put in place to ensure that products were evaluated first in the lab, and then outdoors in actual fishing situations. Penn's reputation for quality flourished.

#### **WORLD RECORDS**

Penn's business expanded worldwide throughout the 1940's and 1950's. Anglers headed to legendary fishing spots like Cabo Blanco, Kona and Brisbane to chase granders and set world records. Kimberly Wiss set a woman's world record with a Penn Senator in 1954 at Cabo Blanco, Peru after battling a 1,525-pound Black Marlin for 75 minutes. In 1955, all 5 new IGFA world records were set with a Penn, including the largest fish ever caught with a rod and reel - a 2,536-pound shark caught by Alf Dean off the coast of Australia. Dean broke his own record in 1959 with a 2,664-pound catch, once again using Penn. By the end of the 1950's, Penn owned world records for virtually every species of saltwater fish.


#### THE NEXT GENERATION


The 1960's proved to be a time of great change for Penn. In 1961, Penn introduced the Spinfisher 700, the world's first saltwater spinning reel. In 1963, Martha's eldest son Herbert took the reins as President and she assumed the position of chairwoman, which she held until retirement in 1978. Even after retirement. Martha remained active as a consultant and advisor. She was honored by the Society for the Advancement of Management in 1977. Martha passed away in August of 1977, and she will be remembered as a pioneer for female business executives, and one of the best lady anglers to ever fish the open seas.

Herbert Henze quickly set out to build Penn and take it to an even greater level than his parents did. Herbert introduced the Penn International gold line of big game fishing reels in 1965. A new boat, the Penn Senator, was employed to carry on the tradition of testing new Penn reels. A new manufacturing facility was opened in 1966 at Hegins, Pennsylvania. The business grew steadily for almost 30 years.











Downriggers were introduced in the 1970's. A third manufacturing facility was opened in 1976 at Kulpsville, Pennsylvania, and a Penn sales office was opened in Japan. Penn rods were developed in the early 80's. Graphite reels and HT-100 drag material were introduced in the mid-1980's. Otto, Martha and Herbert had taken a depression era company with first year sales of just \$7,000, and built the most successful fishing tackle company in America.

#### **NEW OWNERSHIP**

In January 2003, Herbert Henze retired and sold the company to Mr. Jerry Rodstein and Mr. Dick Henry (see page 3), both veterans of the fishing industry and both avid fishermen. The new owners plan to keep the Penn tradition for quality fishing tackle alive and grow the business for decades to come. Penn will continue to operate as the only major fishing tackle company with products made in the United States. The Penn brand will be expanded to include such products as hooks. tackle boxes, terminal tackle and clothing (see pages 74 through 83). New products, coupled with innovative materials and technologies, will become the life blood of Penn's growth. Many new products are featured on the pages throughout this catalog.

We appreciate the many loyal consumers and customers who have contributed to Penn's history over the years. You have our guarantee that Penn will strive to bring nothing but the finest quality products to market, and we will continue to provide the parts and service necessary for you to take care of those products throughout their existence. The memories you have of using Penn's products should last a lifetime.

# Making it Reel... **An International Story**

We build the gold standard in offshore tackle. First there's that slow, hard click. You take a breath, then another ...click You can hear the finely machined teeth on the gear make contact...click. It's the sound of anticipation, of impending battle. Two more clicks. Then a screaming zzzzzzzzzz as all hell breaks loose and the drag on a Penn 50TW International big-game reel goes off, triggering a blast of adrenaline. I instinctively jump for the rod, then stop myself. I'm in downtown Philadelphia.


Like a hound in Pavlov's lab, these sounds trigger an immediate response-one that's completely out of place in the here and now, and which startles the guy sitting next to me at Penn Fishing Tackle Manufacturing. It's not a fish spinning that reel, it's the "finisher" sitting at station #8 on the assembly line, checking to make sure the drag and clicker are functioning flawlessly. Which they are. Only a big Penn can sing like that, and this one is in perfect pitch.

I ease back into my seat at Station #1, next to Ralph, who eyes me warily. My little flashback has slowed down the line, and these guys want to put together 200 reels today. I screw up almost immediately. I put the lever knob cover on but forget to insert a shim first. Ed Stocklin, Penn's assembly department supervisor for 43 years, catches the mistake before I send a botched part down the line. Neither he nor Ralph look happy about baby-sitting me through this. The folks here—some of whom have been on the job for decades—take their work very seriously. I feel bad, but it's the only way to find out what goes on inside the baddest, sexiest reel on the ocean. That is, if they don't fire me

#### **NOT-SO-HEAVY METAL**

Whatever your favorite big-game reel is, you must agree on one thing: Penn makes the gold standard. Internationals have cranked up more marlin, tuna, and wahoo than almost all reels combined. More than 1,200 IGFA world records have been set on Penn reels. In the coming year, Penn's 300 employees will build about 100,000 Internationals and 400,000

### Making it Reel..... Cont.

Since 1932, Penn has been manufacturing reels in Philadelphia. Founded by Otto Henze and named after the state's founder, William Penn, the company's three plants cover a combined 250,000 square feet. Big? In the world of fishing tackle, it's mammoth. Which is why, when we decided to explore the inner workings of a big-game reel, we came here.


The birth of any Penn reel begins in the design room, where computerized and paper designs are created. From there, the idea travels to the tool room, where handmade prototypes are crafted. When a design is ready to go into production, Penn starts from scratch—from sheets and slabs of metal.

To see the first phase of putting together a 50TW International, I went to the Kulpsville facility, about 30 miles north of Philly, where reels begin as massive stacks of forged aluminum. Some get stamped into handle blanks by a 150-ton punch press. Some go to the machining cells, where CNC lathes turn them into side plates of frames. A quick look around the manufacturing floor is mind-boggling. I count the number of 3,000-pound drill presses and 8,000-pound lathes that can machine parts to .0001" tolerances—71. A baker's dozen of injection molds for making handle knobs sit in an area the size of my house. Sonic welders, oil baths, and engraving machines line the walls. At the end of the day, tractor-trailer loads of newly made reel parts will be ready to be shipped to the assembly plant in Philly, where I'll

Many of the parts must be anodized first. At the Philadelphia facility, they show me the "bath," a solution of sulfuric acid and water that opens the aluminum molecules, allowing them to accept the gold dye, and then seals them to protect against corrosion. From the bath, these parts go through a vibrating "tumbler" filled with steel pellets, which take off any rough edges. A polisher then handfinishes each piece.

All of these processes have taken their toll on the metal. The 50TW I will build weighs 67.5 ounces, vet the process started with almost double that weight in raw materials. Penn is proud of its environmental consciousness and finds ways to reuse much of that material. Dumpsters filled with aluminum and steel shavings are sent off to recycling plants every week, and on every floor of the Philly plant there are clearly marked recycling bins.

#### Making it Reel.....cont. LIFE ON THE LINE

I wheel a rack of anodized parts up to assembly and pass room after room of heavy machinery. Some are creating sprockets for spinning reels; some are winding stainless-steel springs; and some are winding drilling screw holes in fabricated parts. Then, as I pass through a room holding several million dollars' worth of gear-carving, tungstencarbide-tipped, oil-bathing automations, I see a bright white box stretching from floor to ceiling. There's a window, and I can't resist a peek. Here I learn that building a reel is high-tech—beyond CNC manufacturing and CAD-CAM designing. Inside the box is a computercontrolled electric discharge machine (EDM) cutting metal with electricity, creating parts with tolerances so tight I can't fit enough zeros across this page to express them.

After watching the EDM in action and getting a hands on lesson in how to chop stainless steel with pure energy, it's time to get back up to assembly. They're probably tapping their feet and glancing at their watches, waiting for me and my cart of parts. But I make another stop as I pass the employees time clock and a huge bulletin board with dozens of thank-you letters from customers an a few copies of magazine reviews-including two of mine. Cool. I'm a star.

But that doesn't mean squat to Ed—he needs reels built. When I return with my parts in tow, he leads me to Station #2. Evidently, I was too slow at Station #1. Rather than do piece work, he suggests that I build and follow a single reel down the line. First, I assemble the spool bearings, four clutch springs, and the pinion. Each hole gets a drop of grease before I attach the ratchet plate. Now I know what makes the clicking sound that gets my adrenaline pumping. At Station #3, I give the frame a left-side plate, two dog springs, and screws, which completes the anti-reverse system. Each hole must be gooped with grease, and before screws are inserted, each hole gets a coat of anti-

I secure the screws by reaching overhead and pulling down an air powered screw gun. There are 19 of these guns on this line, each set for the torque and speed appropriate for the task at that specific station. When I add up the number visible on all four assembly lines, I reach 90, give or take a couple. They're building GTIs one line over, but the other two lines are quiet at the moment. Still, with 40 or so of these screw guns buzzing around me, I keep having nightmarish visions of a dentist's office. Contiune to pg 16

Meanwhile, a pile of partially assembled reels on the conveyer belt keeps getting pushed back by Ed as they almost pass my station without getting dog springs and screws (with my butt parked at this station, no one else can get a job done). I sneak a look back at Ralph, who is chugging right along, adding to the pile. The kind folks at Stations #4 through #8 are all glaring at me, hands sitting idle.

It takes me four minutes to do my little job. At most of the stations, it takes a Penn employee two to three minutes. I move to Station #4 and start putting in freespool and strike buttons, clips for each, a housing with two screws, a clicker, and press in a bushing. At Station #5, I put together the cam mechanism, insert it in the housing, assemble the handle, and line up the gear stud. At Station #6, I assemble the drag system, drop in the spool, insert ratchet and clicker buttons, and screw on the right-side plate. It's starting to look less like a jumble of clock parts.


At Station #7, I insert the lever drag handle, the preset knob, two bushings, and a quadrant, though this part's function still escapes me. The reel looks complete, so it's on to Station #8, where I polish it, spin the spool to check for smoothness, and check the clicker. Next I hook it up to a digital scale, set the lever drag on "strike," and preset it to 21 pounds of tension. Finally, it's time: I shift the reel into freespool, put on the clicker, and turn it slowly. Click...click....Then a rousing spin for the crescendo...zzzzzzzzz Ahhh, I love that sound. I record the serial number and send it down to the packer, who drops it into a box with a manual and parts list.

I look up at Ed. He's been smiling all along, but this time it looks genuine. I know why, too. Finally, he can get this monkey wrench out of his machinery. As he shakes my hand and congratulates me on completing my first International, I noticed that Ralph is making his way over to the packer and nonchalantly pulling a box out of the pile. He looks up and we make eye contact. A streak of quilt appears on his face. " It's not that we don't trust you," he says. "But if a thousand-pound marlin was on the end of your line, you'd want the reel to be perfect, right? Damn straight, Ralph. And the next time I'm using one of these four pound tools to crank on a fish the size of a Volvo, I'll be thinking of you.

Considered by the old salts sitting around the dock telling fish stories to be the most effective means to catch large Striped Bass and Bluefish, wire line trolling has seen a popular revival in the past few years. Sounds simple enough, but before you go and load wire onto any old reel on any old rod, you need to understand a few basics.

Wire line causes aluminum spools to pit and corrode, and with few exceptions, wire line wreaks havoc on guides. So the guestion remains how do these old salts fish wire line when it is such a difficult material to fish. First, your reels, more specifically the spool on your reel, needs to be made with a material that will not develop an electrolytic difference with the wire line. The Penn 113HSP Senator® has been designed with a Chrome-Over Bronze spool and is the "Go-To" reel for anglers fishing wire line. This reel safely handles wire, and quite frankly is your best option for this type of fishing, as no other reel designed to handle wire has the cranking power, drag, and durability as the 113HSP.

As for wire line safe rods, more specifically wire line safe guides, Fuji<sup>®</sup> recently made a breakthrough in guide material, producing a guide that not only stands up to the wear-and-tear of wire, but can also safely handle swivels, a popular connector used with wire, passing through the guides. If you are thinking, am I really tough enough to fish with such a rod, no worries mate, because our rod designers wouldn't let us go off the deep end. We recommended 180-grit sand paper for grip material, but they made us use EVA foam for comfort. We tried to get them to literally make this rod from a broomstick, but they insisted the parabolic taper would be more powerful and angler friendly. Duct Tape was our idea to substitute in place of thread and an epoxy finish, and guides made from a few pieces of wire, but they demanded only quality components and threadwork be permitted. Begrudgingly, we let them win. We must be getting soft in our old age.






